E. Old Business:

F. New Business:

- 1. The proposal of the Association rental change to a single residence has been unanimously passed.

- 3. Jim Yoder discussed maintenance issues of the Larimer units. This concerns clean up around the individual residential units. The maintenance of the plantings, mainly flowers and other plants that are cut down in the fall have costs taken out of the budget to accomplish this task.
